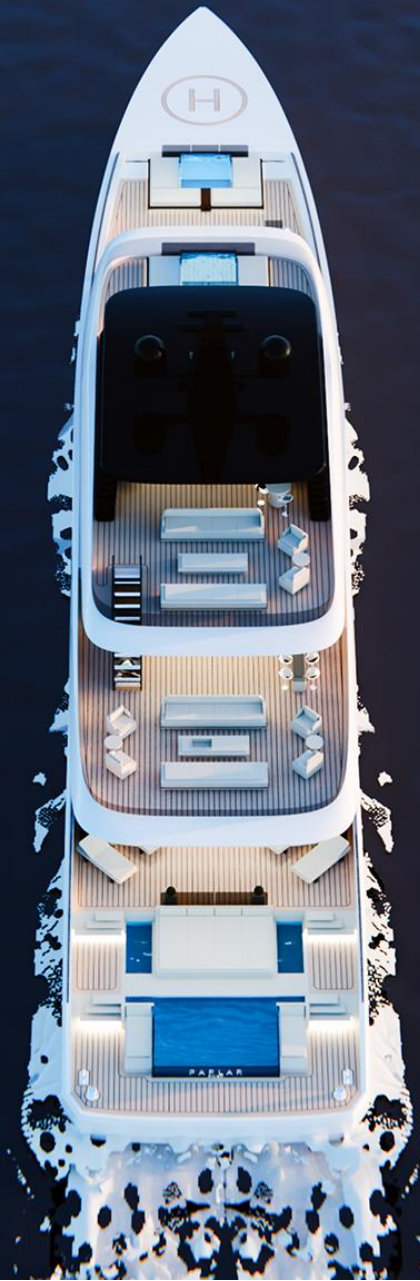

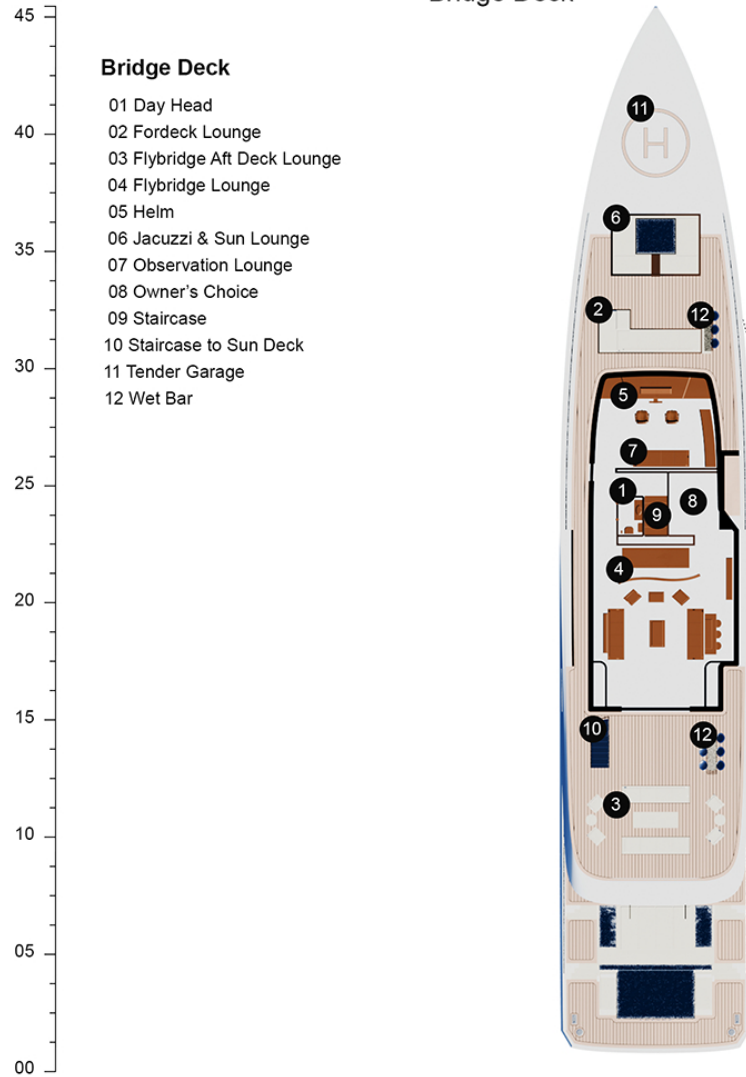

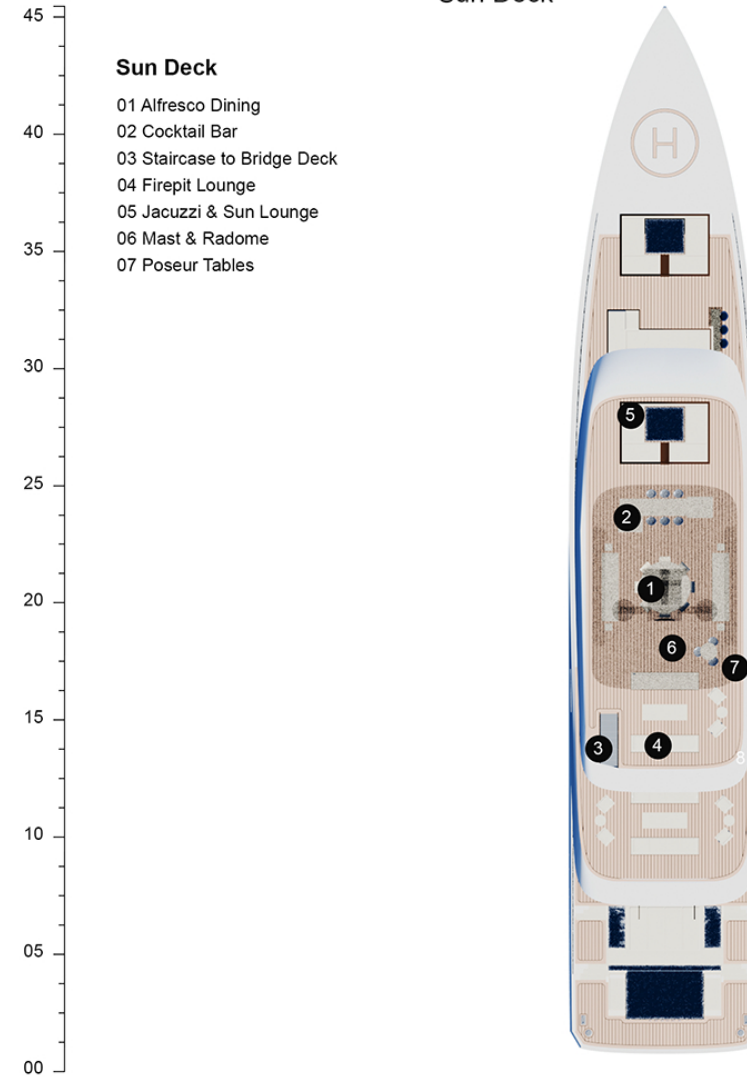

Bridge Deck

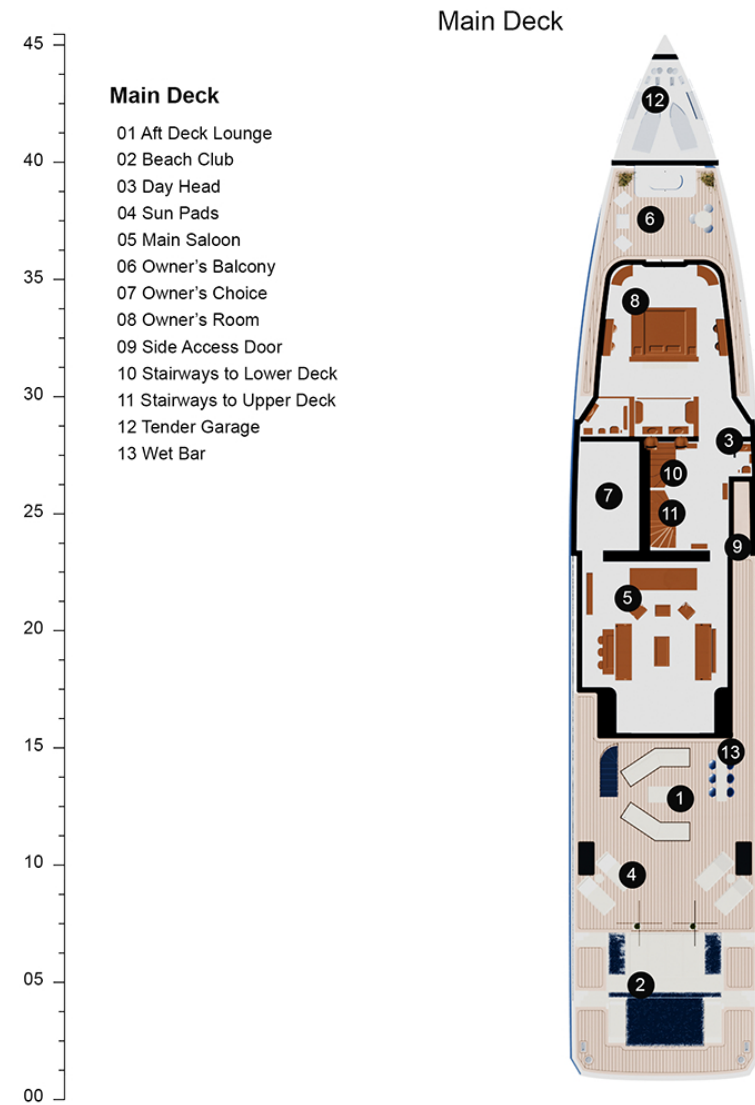
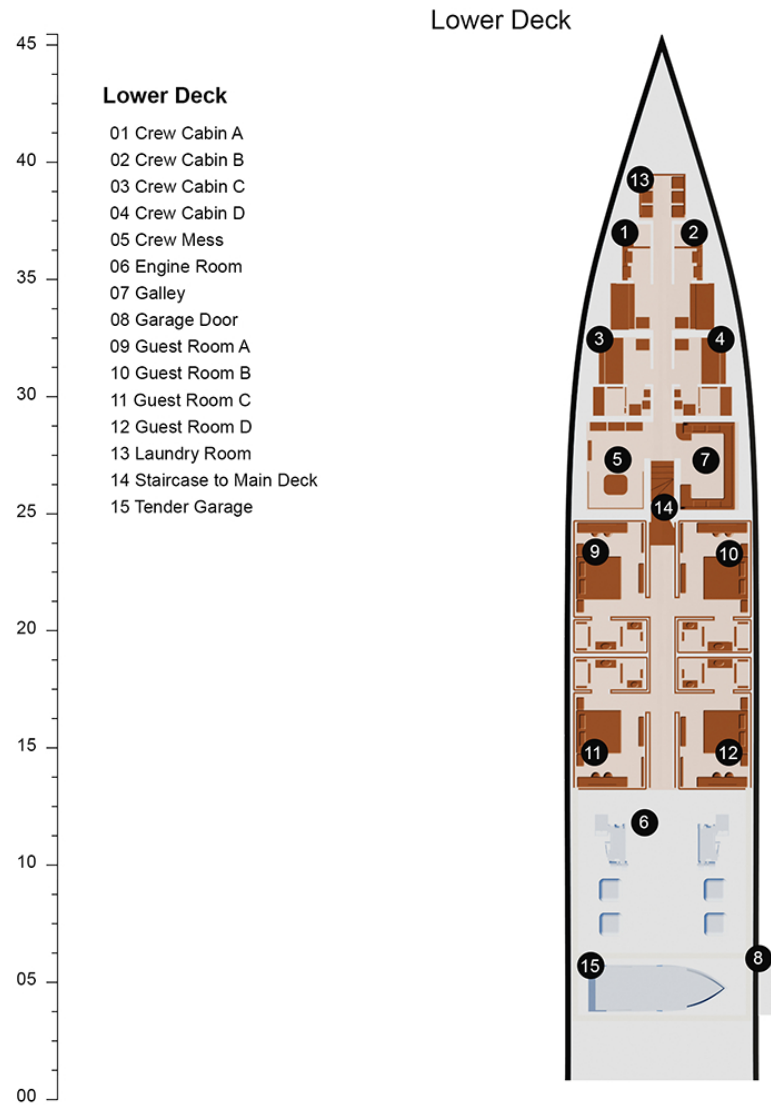


Sun Deck

Designed for transoceanic cruising, the Kilimli 150 combines long-range capability with a shallow draft that enables access to remote shores and pristine destinations — from the Bahamas to the islands of the Andaman Sea. Created to feel like a true home at sea, it provides generous accommodations for family, guests, and crew, ensuring every voyage is as comfortable as it is adventurous.

Measuring 45 meters in length with a 9-meter beam and a shallow 2-meter draft, the Kilimli 150 offers a unique balance of performance, interior volume, and versatility. With a gross tonnage of 499 GT, it delivers the presence and space expected of a much larger yacht, while remaining efficient and practical for global cruising.

Accommodations include four spacious double guest cabins and two private owner's deck areas, offering comfort for up to 10 VIP guests. Crew quarters house up to eight across four cabins, supported by ample walk-in cold storage, enabling extended voyages and ensuring seamless service. The Kilimli 150 integrates luxury with functionality, delivering all the essential elements of a world-class cruising experience — elegance, practicality, and intelligent design.

This project reflects Kilimli Yachts' vision to create a modern expression of craftsmanship that transcends mere function — much like the timeless architecture of Meteora or the Alhambra, where form and purpose converge as art. Beyond steel and timber, these yachts are infused with soul, composed as reflections of human creativity and aspiration. They stand as a reminder that we are more than matter, just as the sea is more than salt and water: it is motion, mystery, and life itself.

Interior Layout & Decks

• Beach Club

The Kilimli 150 welcomes guests through its expansive transom beach club, featuring both fresh- and seawater pools. Positioned just forward, a dedicated lounge offers an intimate connection with the sea, immersing guests in the natural surroundings. Beneath the deck, watertight hatches provide access to utility storage, enabling the crew to efficiently manage mooring operations. Direct access to the engine room and technical compartments is available via the port side passage of the beach club deck.

The area can be further expanded with deployable water pontoons and is complemented by a full suite of tenders and water toys. By night, the beach club transforms into a

versatile entertainment venue — easily converted into an open-air cinema, or, with the addition of a bar and sound system, a vibrant waterside club.

• Main Deck

Twin staircases from the beach club lead to the main aft deck, a spacious, fully covered outdoor area designed for versatility. The seating arrangement converts seamlessly from a relaxed lounge into an elegant dining setting for up to ten guests. A custom-designed bar enhances the social atmosphere, creating a perfect setting for gatherings and entertainment.

A port-side stairway provides guest access to the skylounge deck, while discreet crew circulation is maintained via the side deck. Entry to the main saloon is through a striking full-beam sliding glass door. Inside, the port side accommodates a convertible dining/lounge arrangement for ten guests, while the starboard side features a refined lounge and settee area. Expansive sliding glass doors on both sides flood the saloon with natural light and offer uninterrupted sea views.

At the center of the main deck, a lobby with a day head provides access to the owner's private suite through an adjoining study or dressing room. The full-beam suite offers privacy and comfort, highlighted by a fold-down balcony to starboard and his-and-hers bathrooms finished to the highest standards. From the same lobby, a central staircase connects the bridge deck above and guest accommodations below. A watertight starboard door provides direct access to the foredeck lounge.

• Bridge Deck

The aft terrace offers a sun-protected lounge and dining area for up to ten guests, with a seamless transition indoors via a full-height sliding glass door. The upper deck saloon spans the yacht's full beam, arranged with a bar and generous seating, enhanced by floor-to-ceiling windows that frame panoramic sea views.

A corridor with a day head connects to the wheelhouse, while guests can move forward to the Portuguese bridge and the foredeck lounge. Here, seating, sun pads, and retractable awnings create an inviting retreat. The bow houses the mooring equipment, with access to the tender garage below.

• Rooftop

The sundeck offers an expansive open-air retreat with a bar, BBQ station, and alfresco dining. Forward, a jacuzzi flanked by sun pads provides the perfect setting for relaxation, while the radar arch and antennas are integrated beneath a sleek hardtop.

• Lower Deck

Guest accommodations include four spacious cabins, each with king-sized beds and private en-suites. Two aft cabins feature flexible layouts, converting between twin and king configurations. The cabins are accessed via a central corridor connected to the main deck staircase.

Crew quarters are arranged for efficiency and comfort, including a dedicated staircase to the main deck, a fully equipped laundry, walk-in cold storage, and ample additional storage. Four double cabins, each with en-suite bathrooms, are positioned around a central crew mess. This area also provides direct access to the pump room, storage compartments, built-in tanks, and the bow thruster machinery space, ensuring smooth and discreet operations.

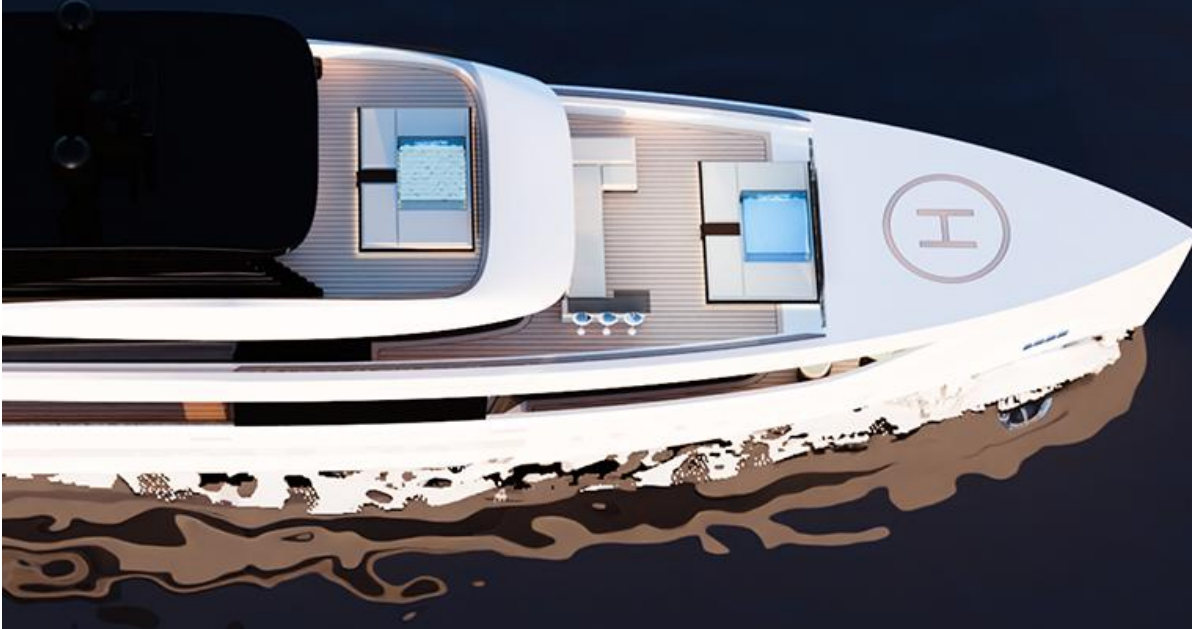
